

Collage to Cartoon. . . and Beyond!

18-hour/3-day hands on design workshop with optional sample weaving

This is the new, expanded version of Molly's popular *Collage to Tapestry Cartoon* workshop. Veterans of that workshop and new students will both find it useful. Highlight your own voice by making your own patterned and painted papers to make collages with your unique style. Explore mark-making to enliven the surface. Learn the steps to refine your collage to make a cartoon you can weave. Then pull out all the stops and explore open warps, irregular edges, stitch and mixed media to bring a collage feel to your weaving. Leave with a cartoon ready to weave.

Suitable for: weavers with some tapestry experience; not a class for absolute beginners

Length: 18 hours/3 days

Minimum/maximum number of students: 6/25

Tuition: \$2250 per group

Tech: screen or blank wall for PowerPoint; Molly can provide projector and laptop as needed

Supplies: sturdy blank paper or sketchbook (at least 8.5 x 11"), vellum or tracing paper, colored and patterned papers, glue stick, scissors, Sharpie, pencil and pen, color pencils, ruler.

Supply fee: \$35 for set of Neocolor II watercolor crayons and paintbrush, use of instructor's supplies
